Agency Updates	<p>Nick DeMott shared Lifeboat hosted a Recovery Mobile Clinic outside their building on 913 W. Holmes Rd. Lansing on 8/5/21. Their primary focus is Vivitrol, but they also provided Covid Vaccinations and rapid testing. Lifeboat is located in the same building as Wellness Inx, Mid-Michigan Recovery Services (MMRS), Lansing Syringe Access (LSA), Lansing Area AIDS Network (LAAN) and a Methadone clinic. This clinic helps meet the needs of people who access services in the area. Additionally, Andrea shared if you would like to join Ingham Substance Abuse & Prevention (ISAP) Please reach out to her at aryan@eatonresa.org</p> <p>Amanda Wallace stated the Medical Examiner's office has confirmed 82 overdose deaths in Ingham County, of the total number of cases, 70 were Ingham County residents. Out of the 82 cases, 4 deaths are considered indeterminate manner, 5 suicides, the rest are considered accidental. Toxicology shows 58 cases had at least fentanyl if not other drugs in their system at their time of death. At least 15 cases showed a mixture of cocaine and fentanyl.</p>

They discussed sharing Jans cell phone number with witnesses and family members who are at the scene of an overdose so that Jan could reach out and talk with them, find out what their needs are and possibly connect them with Rapid Response for available services.</p> <p>Prevention and Early Intervention Subcommittee- Members in attendance- Andrea Ryan, Andrea Carlson, Tamara Jordan and Faithful Ogundiran.
