| Introductions & Background | Welcome, Ground Rules and Introductions- Renold conducted round-robin introductions, reviewed the Ground Rules & Shared Agreements. The floor was opened up for agency updates. |
| Agency Updates | <p>Renold JeanLouis shared he's working on a youth text service where youth residing in Ingham County can subscribe for free and receive bi-weekly text message containing information and resources regarding support for mental health, sexual health, quitting and risk of vaping and marijuana use, nutrition, physical health, local news and things to do beside vaping and using marijuana. Please email him at RJeanLouis@ingham.org if you have any resources/information you would like to share that would be beneficial to teens.</p> <p>Andrea Ryan announced that as of 9/24/21 she will be stepping back from her full time role at Eaton RESA, but will continue case management services. She is starting her own mental health practice and is working with the Saint Johns Call-In Coalition. She will share flyers for upcoming events.</p> <p>Nick DeMott shared Lifeboat started Peer Recovery Coaching at the Outreach Center and City Rescue Mission shelters. Lifeboat is also starting a mentorship program for future Peer Recovery Coaches. An orientation is scheduled for 9/30/21. They are hoping to offer specialized classes and shadowing opportunities to help strengthen skills and build resumes.</p> <p>Dani Meier reported MSHN is looking at studies showing how Black Americans (BA) receive differential treatment by Opioid Treatment Providers (OTP) in addition to lower doses of Methadone during Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT). Studies show BA have higher rates of overdose deaths than Caucasians due to lack of proper care and services. Data that MSHN has collected from counties they serve shows that even in diverse counties, BA are seen at lower rates than the general population and therefore, MSHN would like to reduce health disparities within the black community by reducing stigma and providing greater access to MAT.</p> <p>Tammy Maidlow-Bresnahan mentioned she is revising the SUD Resource Guide based on changes to in person services within the community. An email will be sent out to IOAPI members, asking if any groups would like changes made to their current guide listing.</p> |
