### Respiratory Protection Standard versus Mini Respiratory Protection

Not all work environments, operations or tasks will present the same level of exposure to COVID-19, the standard's requirement for establishment of a respiratory protection program and provision of respirators is not applicable to all employers or all employees. Completing an assessment of the employee's exposure risk based on work task or operation is the required first step.<sup>1</sup>
